

# **English Experts Programme**

The programme aims to develop your language proficiency, teaching practice and research skills. It is designed to provide you with an opportunity to practically apply the principles of active language learning and enhance the use of the 21st century skills in your classroom. As a participant of the English Experts program, you will take part in learner-centred sessions that enriches your critical thinking and problem solving skills. The programme also aims to develop you as an Omani researcher who contributes positively to the education system by doing classroom research. The English Experts Programme consists of three modules:

## **Programme Modules**

### Module 1

aims to raise your awareness of communicative language teaching (CLT) and to use active learning strategies professionally in your classroom.

### Module 2

discusses the application of taskbased learning (TBL), inquiry-based learning (IBL) and flipped learning. It also sheds light on learner motivation and autonomous leaning strategies.

#### Module 3

develops your assessment skills through using well-structured criteria and supporting the use of assessment for learning (AFL) tools.


